We know the steps of salvation: hear, believe, repent, confess, and be baptized. I have repeated these all my life and I have taught them to others. In so doing I have been adamant about the process that needed to be followed and I strongly encouraged others to follow that process. This is right and good. I am concerned, however, that we can make the process more formulaic than sincere. In the pagan world they had to say the right words at the offering to the gods in the right tone and meter, and if they didn't it wouldn't invoke their obligation. I have often wondered if that is not what we might do with the way in which one comes to a knowledge of the truth, and in the way that one lives that life.

I am convinced that people believe the process of salvation ends as one rises up out of the watery grave, but in fact, that process is only just beginning. How do we understand the process of conversion in one who is converted? Do we have any obligations to God after our immersion? The answer is yes! The Christian is to hear the word of God, and heed it. Jesus tells us to take heed how we hear. We are to continue to shape and fashion our lives into what God desires and continue to hear the words of refinement. We are to believe that God cares for us and trust in him to provide for all those necessities of life, both physical and spiritual. We should also have a soft heart that is willing to repent of error in our lives when it creeps in. We are to confess our sins one to another, and to the God of heaven, as we fail in our walk and realize that the blood of his son will continually cleanse us from all sin. We should also immerse ourselves in the word of God and the work of the church. Our lives should be wholly bound up in our identity in Christ. He is the center of it, not a spoke in the wheel. Then we can continue to live faithfully in this life with the promised expectation for the next. Hear, believe, repent, confess, and be baptized are certainly important acts for the non-christian to understand as they begin to grow in their knowledge of Christianity, but after a response is made to that great gospel, all Christians should hear, believe, repent, confess, and be immersed.
